Mrs. Wittlin advised that cars have the right of way when sharing the roads with golf carts. She advised the Committee that if they see golf cart drivers violating the Rules of the Road to get the cart number and report it to Security


Mrs. Wittlin asked the Committee to consider what has been accomplished this past year and what can be done to improve the Committee.
