A three way stop sign system will be installed at the south entrance to Golfside Dr. by the crosswalk at Island Court.

Mrs. Wittlin reported on the Rules of the Road. Mrs. Wittlin explained the concern regarding the safety of the pedestrians and the need to inform them and the golf carts about how to share the cart paths safely. The Committee discussed various resolutions. Mr. Murray suggested that when residents register their golf carts at the beginning of the season, it would be a great opportunity to give them the Golf Cart Rules of the Road.

Mrs. Wittlin stated that there are various responsibilities that can be divided between the Committee members. She would like to create sub-committees and asked the members let her know if anyone had a special interest in a specific security issue.

Mrs. Wittlin talked about the New Member Booklet and the Hurricane Preparedness Outlook and how security is involved.


Mrs. Wittlin advised that if any of the members see a speeding car to note the time and the area and call Security. They can review the camera tapes.
