EMPLOYEE SPOTLIGHT

The personal safety and security of all Boca West Residents and their guests is of paramount importance. Each day hundreds of delivery persons, vendors and contractors pass through our gates while thousands of residents are active in the community. Our highly-trained security officers screen guests, contractors, vendors and patrol the grounds 24/7.

Chief Lastella and his staff provide top notch security for the residents and their guests here at Boca West.

Chief Lastella hails from Long Island, New York. He attended the New York Police Department Academy and worked with the NYC Police Department for eight years. He has been with BWMA Security for 21 years. He started as a Security Supervisor and then was promoted to Chief of Security in 2008.

Ever wonder what a day in the life of Chief of Security is like? Chief Lastella starts his day at 5:30 AM by spending time with the midnight supervisor and discussing any issues that may have occurred in the previous shift. Then at 6:00 AM, he meets with the Captain to discuss any up-coming Club events that require Security and make any adjustments in the security officer schedules as needed. Next, he meets with the PBSO Deputy on duty to find out about any criminal activity that has taken place outside of Boca West. He also meets with Brad Baecht, the Executive Director, to advise him of any important information or issues. At 2:00 PM he

does the same thing with the afternoon supervisor. In between his meetings he patrols the community.

Some of his other job responsibilities include interviewing Security Officer candidates, working with PBSO and AMR, and meeting with the Security and Safety Committee to discuss ways to add and improve the safety and security of Boca West. He has been instrumental

in installing cameras, lighted stop signs, and no climb fencing. He also meets with residents and helps them in any way he can.





Some of these projects are in progress and some are still in the scheduling process. Added to that, was also a huge project to repair one of the drainage culverts at the entrance to Oakbrook and Woodcrest. There was also a retainer wall that had deteriorated to the point of replacement and a cinder block wall was built to replace the wood wall that will be permanent and not

susceptible to rot. Also, selected median beds along Boca West Drive will be receiving new plant material and will be an added benefit to the overall appearance to the beautiful lush landscaping that is on display throughout Boca West.

As this year's winter season fast approaches an upcoming project to look forward to is the recently approved median bed landscape enhancement program with the addition of a variety of trees and palms installed in selected medians. Trees such as Japanese Blueberry, Magnolia, Verawood, Live Oak and Calophyllum will be added. Additionally, palms will be added using Sylvester, Bottle, and Triple Copernecia palms. There

will be two median beds that will be completely redone with the removal of old Queen Palms and all of the under planting and replaced with a landscape plant palette that will reflect the new entrances at Yamato and Jog.

We hope you will be pleased with these new plantings we have chosen to enhance the beauty, to the place we call home, Boca West!

ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL

Considering Making Exterior Home Improvements?

Welcome home to all of our snowbird residents and a heartwarming hello to all of our year around residents!

If you are considering making some exterior home improvements, remember that your project must first be approved by your Village and then by BWMA before you can start any project. Inasmuch as Boca West is a planned community, both your Village and BWMA Architectural Control Committee (ACC) must evaluate the impact the proposed projects/improvements will have on your Village, other residents and Boca West in general.

ALL exterior work needs to go through the ACC approval process, whether it is an individual resident's project or a Village project. The ACC also must review Village wide projects such as painting, paving work, siding work, window, roof replacements, significant landscape alterations, etc.

In order to insure a timely approval, the following information, (which can be obtained from your contractor), must be included with each petition:

- The contractor shall provide applicants with a Certificate
 of Insurance naming the Homeowner and the Homeowner's Village
 as Certificate Holders.
 - The following limits apply:
 - a) Commercial General Liability \$1,000,000
 - b) Worker's Compensation Statutory
 - c) Commercial Automobile Liability for Owned or Leased Vehicles - \$1,000,000
- 2) A copy of the contractor's license showing that the license is active.
- A copy of the contracts governing the job to ensure that the scope of work is consistent with submitted plans. Confidential information can be deleted.
- 4) A copy of the architectural plans if required for a permit.
- Sketches of landscaping along with plant identification, if this is part or all of the petition.
- 6) Paint swatches, samples or color photos of exterior materials proposed. (i.e. roof tiles, siding, pavers, windows, shutters, etc.)
- 7) A survey of the subject property prepared by a licensed surveyor showing the exact location of the proposed work.

The ACC Petition will not be presented to the Architectural Control Committee and will be sent back to the party who submitted the Petition unless the required documentation listed above is received.

Please note this process does take time.

- The first step is for the Homeowner or Village to complete the ACC petition and then obtain all required approvals under the Village governing documents.
- Upon approval by the Village, the petition must be signed by three Village Board members.
- The Village or the Village property manager should then submit a complete petition to the BWMA to be reviewed by the ACC.
- The ACC then reviews the petition and documentation and make a recommendation which will be presented at the monthly BWMA Board meeting.
- Once approved at the BWMA Board meeting, a formal approval letter will be e-mailed to the Homeowner (or to the Village if a Village project), the Village president and the property manager for their records.
- 6) No work should commence until all approvals are received by the Homeowner or Village, including a copy of the Building Permit if required because of the nature of the work. Penalties may be imposed if work is commenced before all approvals are received.

Please be aware that this process is not designed to relieve the Village or the Homeowner from hiring an attorney or other professional to review the project and to ensure that the Village or the Homeowner has proper legal protection in connection with the proposed work. BWMA and the ACC are carrying out their duties as mandated by the applicable procedures and requirements incorporated into the BWMA governing documents and should not be considered as offering legal or architectural advice to the Village or Homeowner in connection with the proposed project.
